- 1. A Courageous Look at the Past:" What are your big lessons from your past?"

Big Question: What tools do I have to work with right now in my life?

Answer: Spiritually, I have three things that give me an advantage:

- 1. God's Presence (John 14:15-20), "...He dwells with you..."
- 2. God's Promise (John 14:16), "...He will give you another **Helper/Comforter...**"
- 3. God's Perspective (His Word, John 16:12-15), "...He will **guide** you into all truth..."

Note: He promises to dwell, comfort, and guide us.

I. My Spiritual Advantage (His Presence and Promise) John 14:15-20, NKJV

Note: The Spiritual Promise Comes With One Condition

- 15 "If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.19 "A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live also. 20 At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.
- A. The Condition: You must keep, not throw away, my commandments (or instructions) v.15
- B. The Promise: You will have the presence of God's Spirit (The Spirit of Truth) in your life

II. My Spiritual Advantage (His Perspective in His Word)

John 16:12-15, NKJV

• 12 "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. 13 However, when He, **the Spirit of truth**, has come, **He will guide you into all truth**; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears **He will speak**; and **He will tell you things to come.** 14 **He will glorify Me,** for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. 15 All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.



Four Things The Spirit of Truth Promises To Do

- 1. He will **guide** you into the truth
- 2. He will **speak** to you
- 3. He will **tell you things to come**
- 4. He will honor and glorify God
