1. God Promised to be Present: "I will never leave you nor forsake you"

• 6 Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, **He is the One who goes** with you. **He will not leave you nor forsake you.**"

2. God Admonished Joshua to be Present: "You must go with this people to the land"

• 7 Then Moses called Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, "Be strong and of good courage, for **you must go with this people to the land** which the Lord has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall cause them to inherit it. 8 And the Lord, **He is the One who goes** before you. **He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you**; do not fear nor be dismayed."

14:1 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

• 16 And I will pray the Father, and **He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever**—17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for **He dwells with you and will be in you.** 18 **I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you**
