# The Truth About Paul

#### 1. There were some things he didn't understand about himself

• 15 What I don't understand about myself is that I decide one way, but then I act another, doing things I absolutely despise.

#### 2. There were some things he could not figure out alone

- 16 So if I can't be trusted to figure out what is best for myself and then do it, it becomes obvious that God's command is necessary.
- 3. There were things he knew but did not do (I sabotage myself)
- 17 But I need something more! For if <u>I know the law but still can't keep it</u>, and if the power of sin within me keeps sabotaging my best intentions, I obviously need help! 18 I realize that I don't have what it takes. I can will it, but I can't do it. 19 I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway. 20 My decisions, such as they are, don't result in actions.
  <u>Something has gone wrong deep within me</u> and gets the better of me every time. 21 It happens so regularly that it's predictable. The moment I decide to do good, sin is there to trip me up.

## 4. There were times he struggled with God

- 22 I truly delight in God's commands, 23 but it's pretty obvious that not all of me joins in that delight. Parts of me covertly (*or secretly*) rebel, and just when I least expect it, they take charge.
- 5. There were times he was tired of everything
- 24 **I've tried everything** and nothing helps. **I'm at the end of my rope**. Is there no one who can do anything for me? Isn't that the real question?

## 6. There was one answer to all of his issues, Jesus

25 <u>The answer, thank God, is that Jesus Christ can and does.</u> He acted to set things right in this life of contradictions where I want to serve God with all my heart and mind, <u>but am pulled by the influence of sin to do something totally different.</u>
